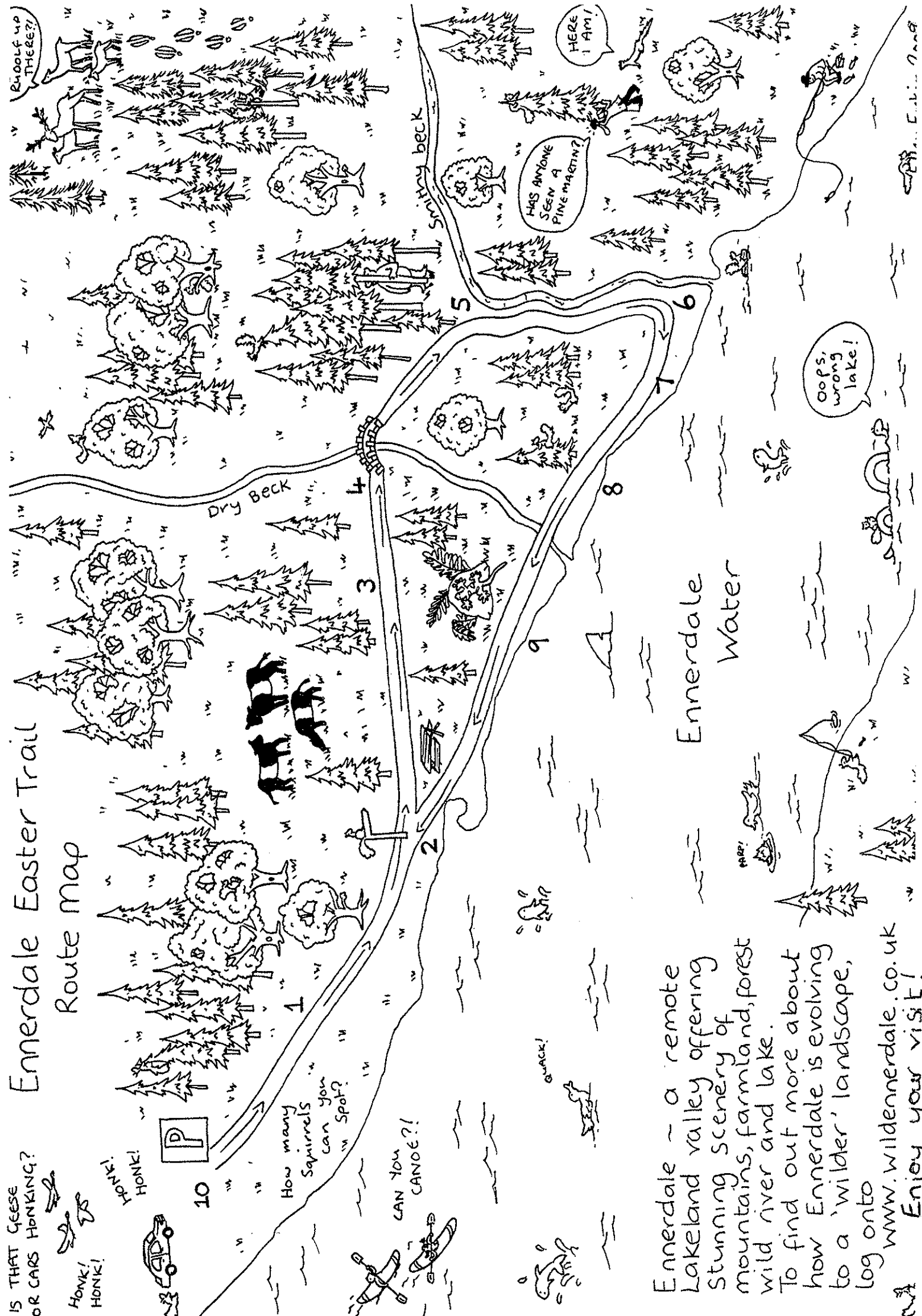


Ennerdale Easter Trail Route Map

Towering mountains and wagging tails

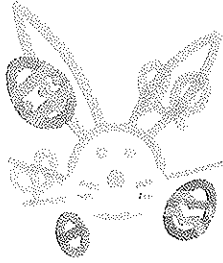
To end the day with an easter egg tale.
